IMPORTANT: Safeguarding and Health & Safety Update

- If we cannot reach you in an emergency, we must be able to contact an alternative trusted adult without delay.
- If your child carries an EpiPen or similar AAI adrenaline device, please email lucie.vezey@croydon.gov.uk to arrange a short but essential discussion about how CMA will safely support its use.
